<sup>\*</sup> Liberal Arts: Courses offered by the General Education Center are divided into 4 categories with a total of 8 credits. Students must obtain at least 2 credits in each category before graduation.

<sup>\* &</sup>quot;English for Proficiency Tests" will be offered in the second semester of the second grade, and it is a required course of 1 credit and 2 hours.

Physical education: the first grade is a required course (the first and second semesters are 0 credit and 2 hours), and the second, third and fourth grades are elective courses.

<sup>\*</sup> Labor education: the first grade is a compulsory course (the first semester and the second semester are both 0 credit and 2 hours).

<sup>\*</sup> Regulations on the number of credits for students to graduate: at least 128 credits are required to graduate, including 84 credits for required courses (Basic General Studies 10, Core General Studies 10, English Proficiency Tests 1, Common for College 9, professional courses 54), 8 required credits (Liberal General Studies), and 36 elective credits (At least 27 credits of major electives in the department).

<sup>\*</sup> Foreign students are allowed to take "Mandarin" as the Second Foreign Language.

<sup>\*</sup> The hours of off-campus internship courses are implemented in accordance with the school's "Off-Campus Internship Guidelines for Students" and the regulations of the Ministry of Education.

<sup>\*</sup> A maximum of 18 credits are recognized for off-campus internship credits in graduation credits

<sup>\*</sup> The elective course subtotal refers to the minimum number of credits/hours that should be offered in the semester.
